

STUDYBLUE

(FLASHCARDS ON YOUR CELLPHONE AND/OR ON YOUR COMPUTER)

On your cellphone

To search for flashcards and save them into your backpack:

- 1) In App Store (iPhone) or Google Play (Android phone), search for studyblue (all one word). It will show up as StudyBlue flashcards. Download the app to your phone.
- 2) Open the app and create an account (either sign up with Facebook or just create an account).
- 3) Click the search icon (the magnifying glass icon), then click on classmates to do a classmate search for Robin Klement.
- 4) It will pull up the name Robin Klement. Click on the name and it will bring up a list of classes (Spanish 1, Spanish 2, French 2, French 3, etc.)
- 5) Click on the class you need. Then scroll down to find the flashcard set you need.
- 6) Open the flashcard set, then click on Actions (top right of screen) and select Save. This will save that flashcard set to your backpack.

To do the flashcards:

- 1) Click on Backpack (looks like a little file folder – should be the second icon from the left at the bottom of the screen). The flashcards you have saved into it will appear in the My Study Materials list. They are named by level, chapter and section (Spanish 1 Ch. 5.1 for example) and also have a description of what topic(s) are covered in those flashcards.
- 2) Click on the icon for the flashcards you want to study. Select the number of flashcards you want to study (5, 10, 20 or all) by sliding your finger up or down in the first column. Select Flashcards in the second column. (You can also select Review sheet instead of Flashcards in the second column to get a list of the words in both languages without having to flip through the cards). Select Shuffled or In Order from the third column (you can't select Hardest to Easiest or Least Studied with the free app). If you have already done the flashcards before, you can also select Study the wrongs to only study the ones you got wrong previously. Then hit Study Now and the first card will appear.
- 3) To flip the card over, hit the circle to the right of the card. If you got it right, hit the green thumbs up icon. If you got it wrong hit the red thumbs down icon (it will keep track of those you get right vs. those you get wrong).

On your computer

- 1) Go to <http://www.studyblue.com/> and then follow the instructions above.

You can also set up your own classes (file folders in your backpack) and make your own flashcards.
